Breakout Brainstorm Sessions: The McPherson County LEPC Exec. Team identified four goals in our December 2023 strategic planning. Those goals are listed below and will be the focus of these breakout sessions. Please plan to actively participate in the one you feel has the most interest and impact to you and your organization.

- **Tier II Data Collection and Deep Dive Analysis** – Tier II data is the foundation for establishing a communities preparedness capability. If you support a Tier II or RMP facility, you should strongly consider this session.
- **Community Emergency Notification Systems** – Everbridge/CIVIC Ready. This breakout will review current capabilities of the two systems and discuss opportunities for improvement as the County and City work to collectively use one or both systems.
- **LEPC Marketing Campaign, Website, Community Outreach and Education** – If you have experience in any of these categories, this is an opportunity to positively impact our community.
- **Training, Touring, Presenter Opportunities** – We want input from our membership on what they feel will have the most impact on our core group continuous improvement process.
